Employ Florida is a powerful online tool specifically designed to help connect employers and job seekers. This tool is another component of the Employ Florida network of workforce services and resources. The Employ Florida Hurricane Recovery Portal has been created to address the mutual needs of Florida businesses, organizations and job seekers who have been negatively affected by Hurricane Irma by highlighting statewide job openings supporting the recovery efforts.

Employers can use the portal to:

- Quickly locate qualified employees to aid the recovery process.
- Designate hurricane recovery jobs with a hurricane icon.
- Securely communicate with job seekers, workforce customer service representatives, training providers and others via the system's internal messaging center.
- Set up a Virtual Recruiter Search Agent to find qualified candidates automatically.

Job Seekers can use the portal to:

- Quickly identify hurricane recovery positions.
- Review resources available to job seekers.
- Learn about and apply for government services and benefits.
- Track work search efforts through an online resume and contact storage center.
- Securely communicate with employers and workforce staff through the system's internal email and message center.
