Our Work Experience Program provides young adults with an opportunity to experience the world-of-work, explore potential careers, and gain essential work readiness and life skills. This program combines preliminary training in work readiness skills with a work experience opportunity at a local business or non-profit organization.



During the work experience component of the program, youth are placed in a business or organization and assigned work duties related to the identified position. The host business or organization does not pay the youth. CareerSource Southwest Florida provides the youth with worker's compensation and an hourly wage of \$10.50/hr. for up to 480 hours of employment. The goal of the work experience is to help youth learn to be outstanding employees and to gain valuable job specific skills so that they are prepared to secure competitive employment in the future.
