### CALL TO ORDER

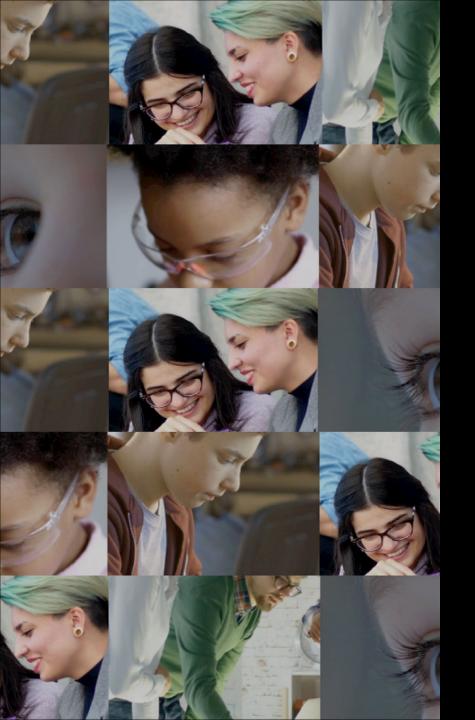
