What is the Welfare Transition Program?

Florida's Welfare Transition (WT) program is designed to provide Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA) recipients with training, education, support services, and skills needed to gain unsubsidized employment.

Work eligible TCA recipients are referred to the WT program and are provided an assessment of education levels, employability skills and work history.

Individualized Career (*iCareer*) pathway activities are available to enhance employability skills.

iCareer pathway activities include:

- GED
- ESOL
- Adult Basic Education
- Work Readiness Workshops
- Career Exploration
- Work Experiences
- Short Term Certification Training
- Job Search Preparation
